



5. The corporation applies for the issue of supplementary letters patent to provide as follows: La personne morale demance la délivrande de lettres patentes supplémentaires qui prévoient ce qui suit:

Vary the provisions of the supplementary letters patent of the Corporation dated February 20, 2004, November 3, 2002 and August 10, 1979 by deleting them in their entirety and replacing them with the following:

- 1. The objects for which the Corporation is incorporated are:
  - (a) to operate, maintain and manage a hospital to provide treatment, care and comfort of persons suffering from illness or disability;
  - (b) to promote and carry on teaching and scientific research activities related to the care of the sick and injured, insofar as such teaching and research can be carried on in, or in connection with, the Corporation; and
  - (c) to equip, maintain and operate laboratories and all other services incidental to a hospital.

## 2. The special provisions are:

- A. The corporation shall be carried on without the purpose of gain for its members and any profits or other accretions to the corporation shall be used in promoting its objects.
- B. The corporation shall be subject to the Charities Accounting Act and the Charitable Gifts Act.
- C. The directors shall serve as such without remuneration and no director shall directly or indirectly receive any profit from their positions as such, provided that directors may be paid reasonable expenses incurred by them in the performance of their duties.
- D. The borrowing power of the corporation pursuant to any by-law passed and confirmed in accordance with section 59 of the Corporations Act shall be limited to borrowing money for current operating expenses, provided that the borrowing power of the corporation shall not be so limited if it borrows on the security of real or personal property.
- E. If it is made to appear to the satisfaction of the Minister, upon report of the Public Guardian and Trustee, that the corporation has failed to comply with any of the provisions of the Charities Accounting Act or the Charitable Gifts Act, the Minister may authorize an inquiry for the purpose of determining whether or not there is sufficient cause for the Lieutenant Governor to make an order under subsection 317(1) of the Corporations Act to cancel the letters patent of the corporation and declare it to be dissolved.
- F. Upon the dissolution of the corporation and after payment of all debts and liabilities, its remaining property shall be distributed or disposed of to charities registered under the Income Tax Act (Canada), in Canada, which provide health care services in the Cambridge area.
- G. To invest the funds of the corporation in such manner as determined by the directors, and in making such investments the directors shall not be subject to the Trustee Act, but provided that such investments are reasonable, prudent and sagacious under the circumstances and do not constitute, either directly or indirectly, a conflict of interest.
- H. For the above objects, and as incidental and ancillary thereto, to exercise any of the powers as prescribed by the Corporations Act, or by any other statues or laws from time to time applicable.
